

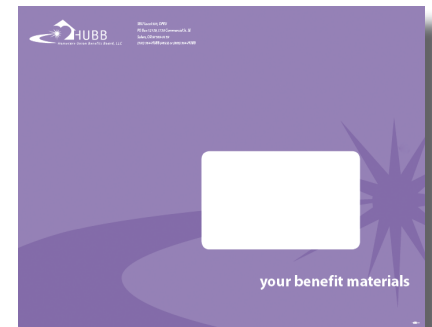
2008 Contract Renewal information on its way soon

New HUBB plan information coming to a mailbox near you soon!

Look for your 2008 HUBB plan renewal information in the mail in late March. Every year about this time HUBB negotiates new insurance contracts with both Kaiser and ODS. Please take the time to get that big purple envelope out of your mailbox, and review the new information.

HUBB has negotiated with insurance carriers to get Homecare workers and their families the best medical, dental and vision insurance possible. The renewal packet includes any benefit changes to the current ODS and Kaiser Permanente plans, changes to the monthly premium that the State contributes for you, the homecare worker, and changes to the homecare worker's premiums for family coverage. Homecare workers with families enrolled in the program and COBRA participants will get new premium payment information in the mail. All changes will go into effect April 1, 2008

Changes to the ODS Prescription Drug Program

Oregon Prescription Drug Program

Effective April 1, 2008, prescription drugs benefits on the ODS Medical Plan will be administered through the Oregon Prescription Drug Program (OPDP). This new program will provide homecare workers and family members with additional discounts on the cost of prescription drugs covered by the Plan.

The passage of SB 362 in 2007 provided a way for all Oregonians to participate in the savings available through this new state program. As a result, HUBB can take advantage of the purchasing power of a very large purchasing group and will receive guaranteed performance standards and price transparency.

Homecare workers and their family members covered on the ODS Medical Plan will experience these savings. Under this new arrangement, the Prescription Drug Program will have a revised list of participating pharmacies. Participants in the plan must purchase their prescriptions at the participating pharmacies to receive plan benefits. If prescriptions are purchased at non-participating pharmacies, the homecare worker must pay for the cost of the drug and, then, can bill ODS Medical Plan for reimbursement.
